Jump Start is an enrichment program designed for students who will attend Summit Ridge starting in the fall of 2019. It is a unique opportunity to help students feel more confident and comfortable about entering middle school and completing a strong transition from elementary school. Students of every skill level will benefit from the chance to attend Jump Start. All classes will be kept to 18 students or under.

The most popular class is our *Success for Success for Middle School Class*, "Hawk Time". This class includes the chance for students to become familiar with lockers, school layout, class expectations, and have the opportunity to meet other students and teachers. Other classes involve reading, writing, math, science and computer technology exploration. All classes involve differentiation, so that students can cover basic skill review or be challenged with upcoming curriculum. Classes also incorporate preparation for transitioning from one or two teachers, to having six different subjects and teachers.
